

How to run a Period Promise Collection Drive

It's easy to be a part of Period Promise, but that doesn't mean that we don't need your help. We can only get product into the hands of people who need it, if people like you, get involved and run a collection drive in your workplace, book club, community centre, or wherever it is that you live your life!

Keep it Simple

These 5 easy steps can quickly make a successful collection. But from this foundation you can get as elaborate as you like.

1. *Choose a timeframe* between March 3 and March 21 to run a campaign.
2. *Print off some posters* and hang them up.
3. *Grab a box* and put it in a common space with the *Donate Here* sign.
4. *Email your colleagues, tell your friends, or neighbours* that you're running a collection.
5. *Share graphics and website* www.periodpromiseniagara.com on your social media channels
6. *Bring your collection to the drop off location of your choosing.*

Run an Event

Go the extra mile and hold a short event to support your collection. This is a great way to explain why Period Promise is important to so many people in our community. It could be over a lunch break or a post-work social.
