The pandemic created ideal conditions for intimate partner violence and abuse to thrive. The stress of a global pandemic, economic recession and upheaval of social supports created the perfect storm for domestic violence to materialize.

Domestic violence has a profound impact on children. Children who witness violence in the home have twice the rate of psychiatric disorders as children from non-violent homes. Over 500 women needed access to safe housing in 2020

## **IMPACT**



"I needed a safe place to stay, as I was fleeing abuse and could not go home. There was a space in transitional housing that became available. Since it is not temporary like a shelter, it has allowed me time to settle and rebuild. If I were not involved in this program, my options were either to stay in a shelter or become homeless while waiting for affordable housing.

This program provided me with a safe place to live, where I feel supported and where my family and I can breathe while we re-start our lives free from violence."
